



iNaturalist Mobile App for Android or Apple

iNaturalist is a citizen science project and online network of naturalists, citizen scientists, and experts used to map and share observations of biodiversity across the globe.

Volunteers are encouraged to report observations during the May 5th event using iNaturalist. **Please be sure to create an account and download iNaturalist prior to the May 5th event.**

Step 1: First you will need to create a *free* account at <https://www.inaturalist.org/>. Select 'Sign Up' and create username, password, etc.

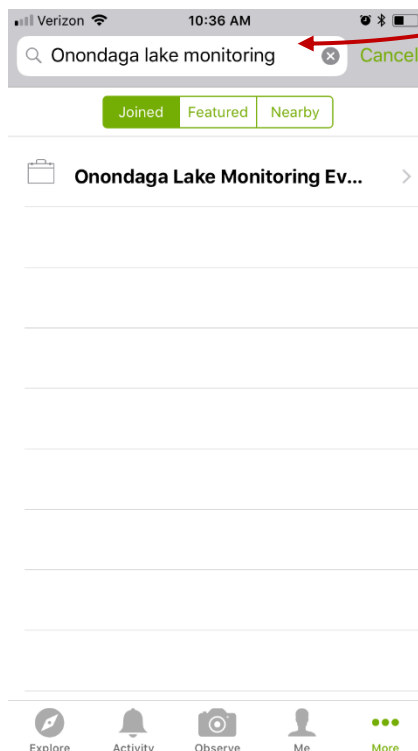
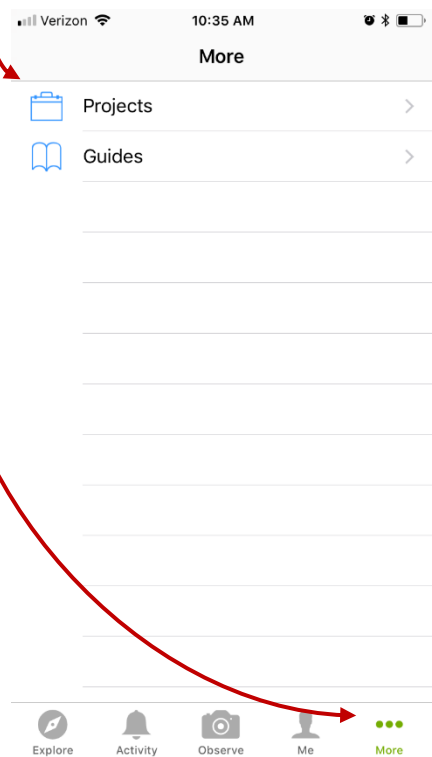

Step 2: Download the *iNaturalist* app on your smartphone and sign in with your username. Please turn on location services so that data uploaded is being tracked to the accurate location.

Step 3: Once you sign in to the app on your phone, click the 'More' button.

Step 4: Select 'Projects'.

Step 5: Search for **Onondaga Lake Monitoring Event**, select, and hit 'Join'.



Reporting observations to this project will allow us to identify, organize, and manage the observations collected on the day of the event.

This will enable volunteers to track the project and will help professionals use the data for future projects, monitoring events, and management decisions.
